Barney's mother used Sudbury as place of Alexander's birth for Seattle Genealogical Society's 5 Generation member lineages published (mimeograph?) in about 1954. His mother was Mrs Sheldon Strong Smith. She was Jessie Alice (Gould) Smith born Westboune Manitoba 1884 died 10 Oct 1958 Seattle, King Washington. Sheldon was born May 8 1880 in Winona Minnesota (the unnamed child in 1880 US Federal census), died 20 Apr 1968 in Seattle.
